During the examination I will collect all necessary clinical data, along with any necessary x-rays and intraoral photographs (not provided by your family dentist).

Following the examination, I will discuss my preliminary impressions of these findings and arrange a consultation appointment. I will share

a review my evaluation, provide a perspective on what the findings may mean, and develop a treatment approach, coordinated with your family dentist, that meets your individual needs.

In your introduction pack, you will find new patient registration information along with medical and dental history forms. Please complete all forms prior to your appointment. This will allow us to focus our time on getting to know each other and evaluating your dental issues and concerns.

My practice is a patient centered, private, fee for service practice. This means payment for service is expected at the time of your visit. If you have dental insurance, we will file a claim(s) on your behalf with your dental insurance carrier. Please be sure to provide all necessary information regarding your insurance to assist us in processing your insurance efficiently. My staff is also prepared to assist you in meeting your dental expenses by working directly with finance institutions.

Please make every effort to keep your appointment. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your appointment time so that my staff can greet you and be sure that all of your personal and insurance information is complete.
